128MB RAM memory

# HOW TO INSTALL “ISAAC FOR WINDOWS” SOFTWARE

*Isaac 5.x is not compatible with Windows XP or older*

**Windows (Windows 7, 8 and 10)**

1) Download the latest version of Isaac for Windows software here:

2) If you’re installing Isaac for Windows on a Windows 10 computer, make sure your security settings in Windows 10 allow for correct installation. More information is available here:



3) Install Isaac 5.x+ software

4) Plug in your USB cable to your PC. Connect the other end of the cable to your PowerPod/Newton, and **make sure your PowerPod/Newton is turned on.**

A series of messages will appear telling you that your USB drivers have been installed successfully.

Once your Isaac software is installed (and USB drivers, if necessary), click on the Start button. You’ll see the Isaac for Windows icon in your menu:
